Gentlemen:

In further response to your letter of October 5th, asking for an estimate of the cost of two (2) H-III No.12 type Stirling Boilers, with stokers, brickwork and combustion control, we submit the following for your consideration:

We estimate that the cost price of two (2) H Boilers of 212 h.p. each, good for a pressure of 160 lb., arranged with a setting height of 10 ft. to receive side dump stoker, delivered and installed with closed shop labor on foundations furnished by you, would be approximately - - - - - (\$11,000.00).
ELEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS - - - - -

We estimate that the price for Diamond Soot Blower Equipment for these boilers, delivered and installed with closed shop labor would be approximately - - - - - (\$ 1,800.00).
ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS - - - - -

We estimate that the price for two brickwork settings, with undercut rear wall, arranged to receive side dump stokers, delivered and installed with closed shop labor, would be approximately - - - - - (\$ 7,600.00).
SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS - - - - -

We estimate that the price for two Steam Driven Westinghouse side dump stokers, equipped with steam driven forced draft fans, suitable for firing the above mentioned boilers when they are evaporating at 200% of rating, delivered and installed with closed shop labor, would be approximately - - - - - (\$ 5,700.00).
FIVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS - - - - -

At present we do not have available prices covering combustion control equipment. Our subsidiary, the Bailey Meter Company, is working up these prices, and we will forward them as soon as they are received by us.


Please note that the prices for brickwork and for the stokers include a handling charge of 15%. In the event that you would furnish this equipment yourselves, this handling charge could be saved by you.
